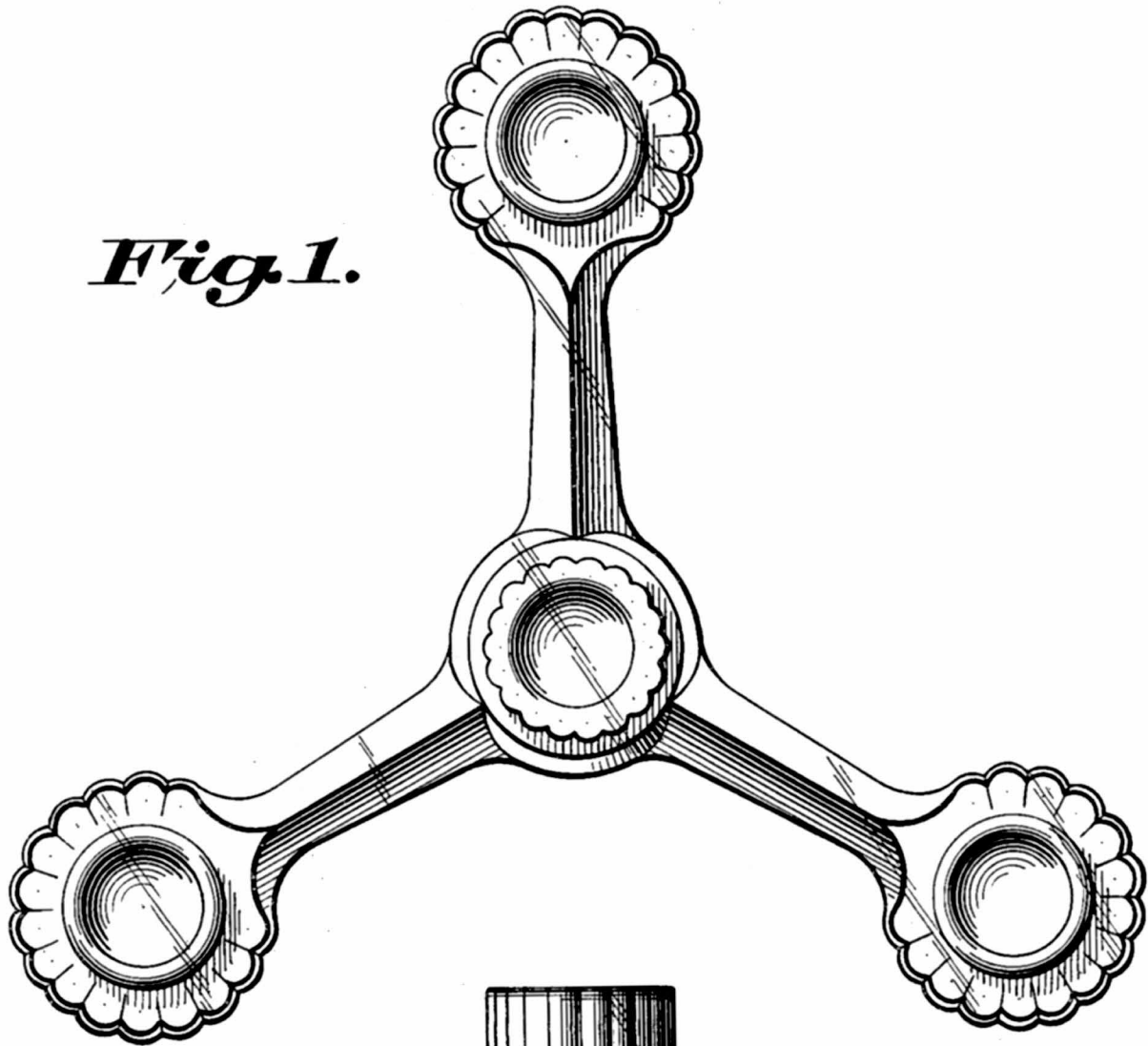
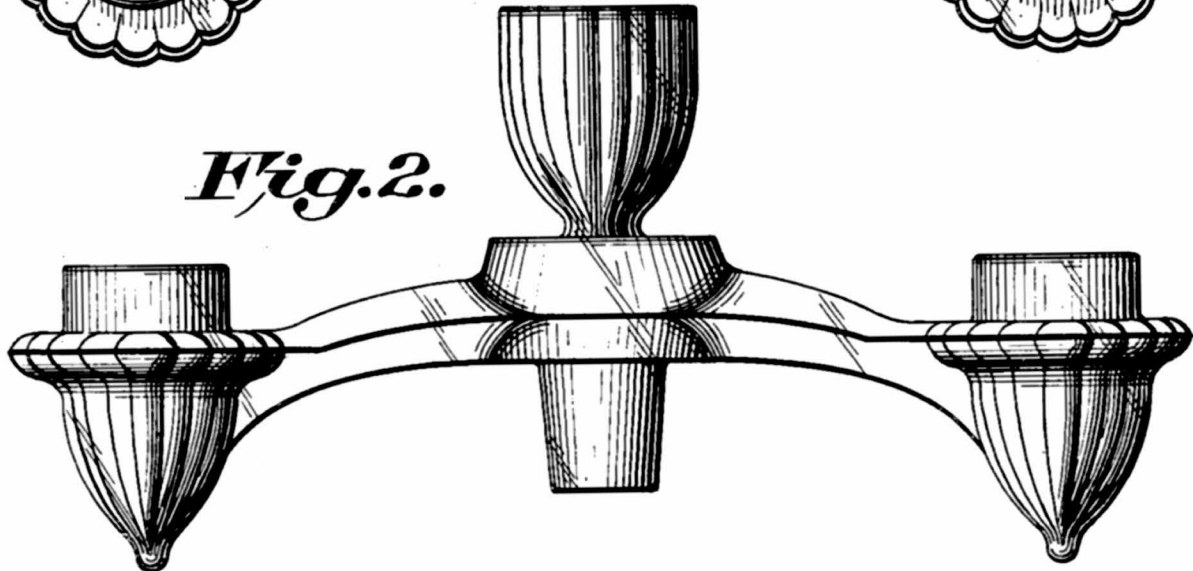

DESIGN FOR A CANDELABRUM ARM OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Wilbur L. Orme, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Candelabrum Arm or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan elevational view of a candelabrum arm or similar article, showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the same.
