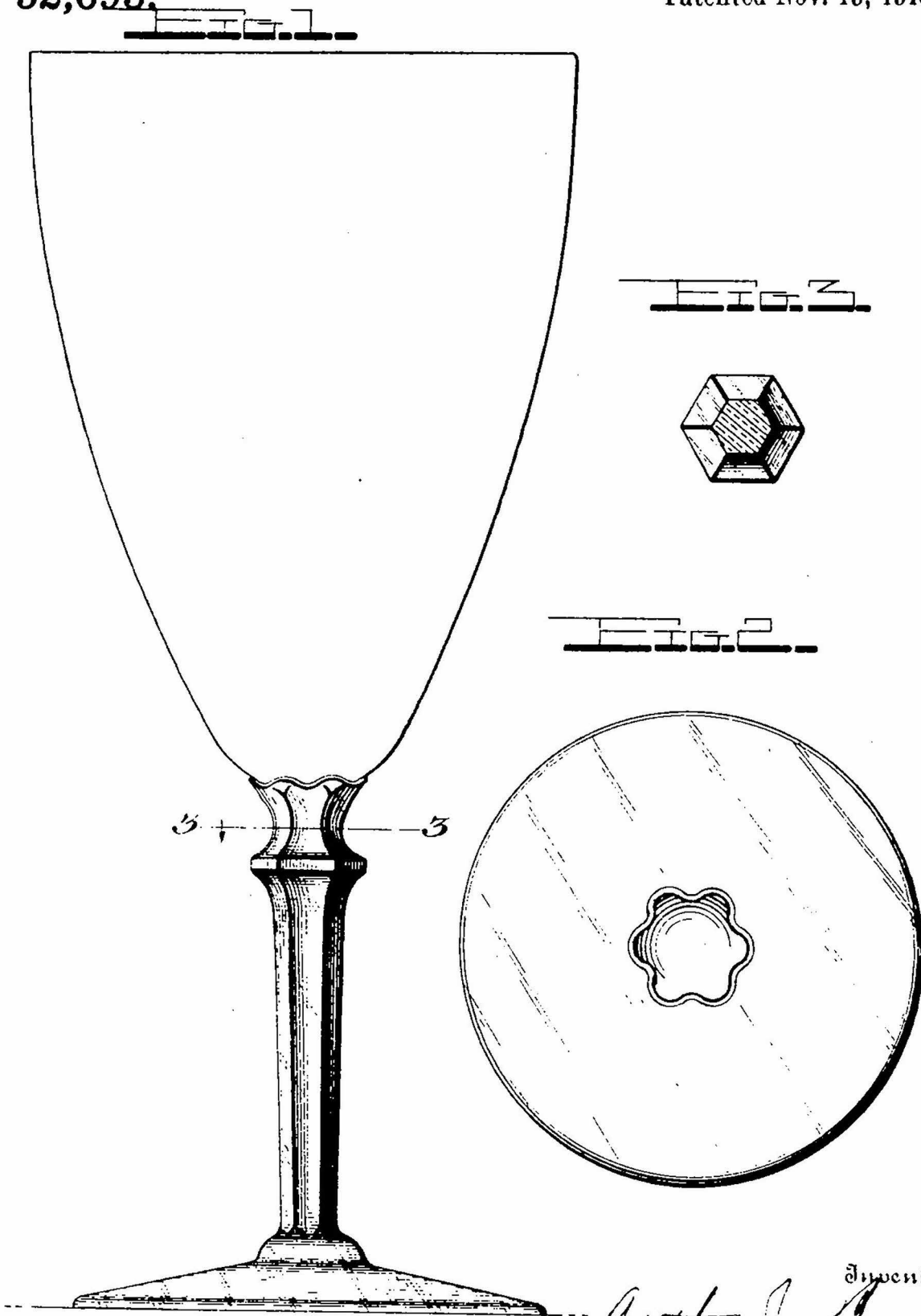

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ARTHUR J. BENNETT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Glass Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a goblet showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view the bowl being omitted; and

Fig. 3 is a section on the line 3—3 of Fig. 1 the base being omitted.

The present invention resides in the stem shown as associated and used with structures of similar nature.

The ornamental design for a glass article, as shown.
