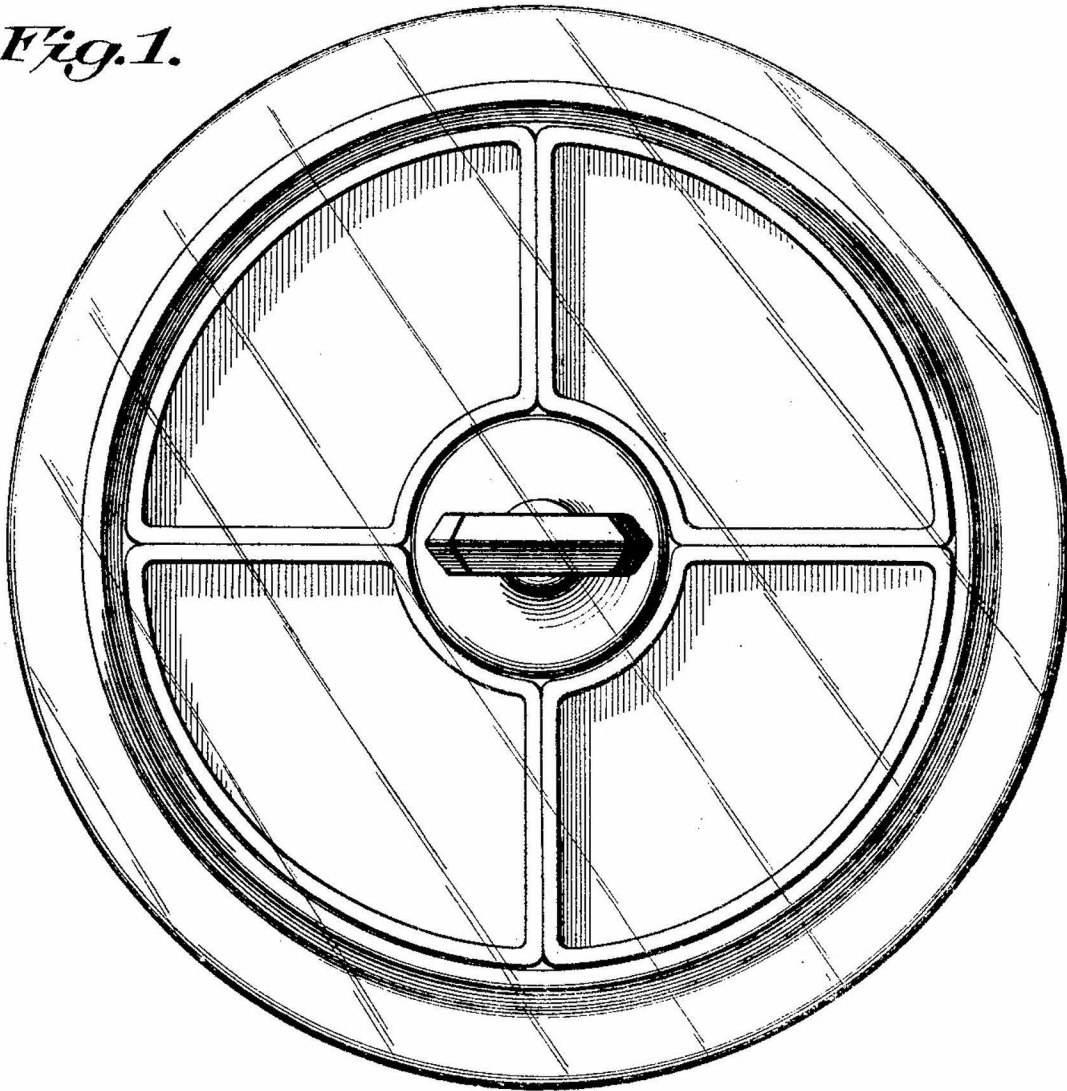
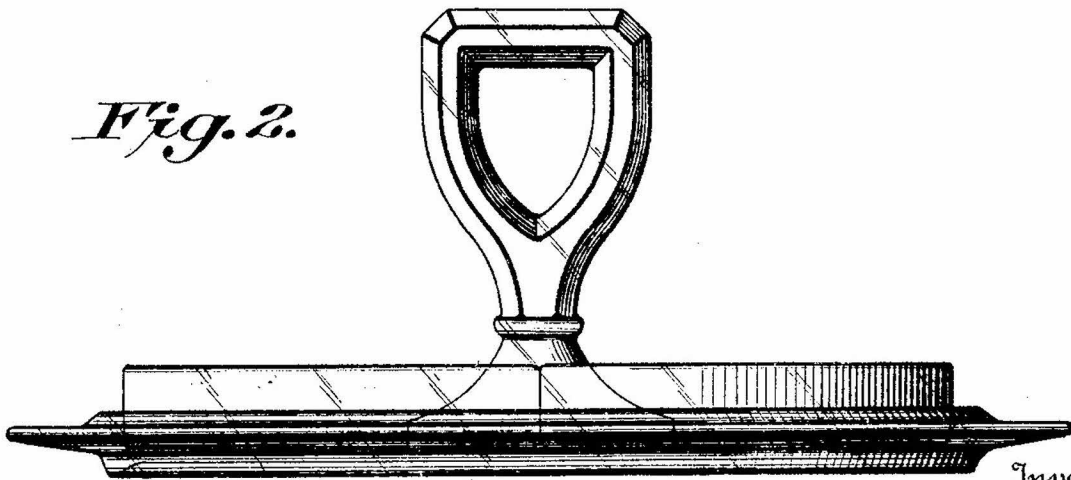

DESIGN FOR A RELISH DISH.

Application filed June 2, 1924. Serial No. 9,771. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR J. BENNETT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Relish Dish, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
