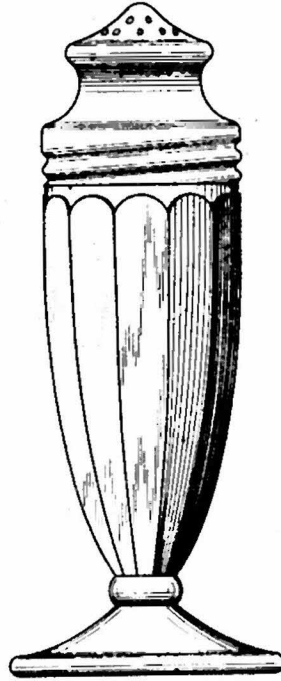

DESIGN FOR A SALT AND PEPPER SHAKER.

Application filed April 2, 1926. Serial No. 17,170. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILL CAMERON McCARTNEY, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Salt and Pepper Shaker, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

The figure is a side elevation of a salt and pepper shaker, showing my new design.

An important feature of the invention resides in the cap which has a neck of considerably reduced diameter at its top that flares outwardly and downwardly and below

which neck a threaded base portion occurs of substantial width and of equal diameter. The body of the shaker has an upper part of uniform diameter, for a considerable portion of its length, and which is equal to the diameter of the base portion of the cap whereby a continuous unbroken effect is had and one wherein the bottom edge of the base of the cap affords a line that binds the cap to the curved upper ends of the panels of the body.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a salt and pepper shaker, as shown and described.
