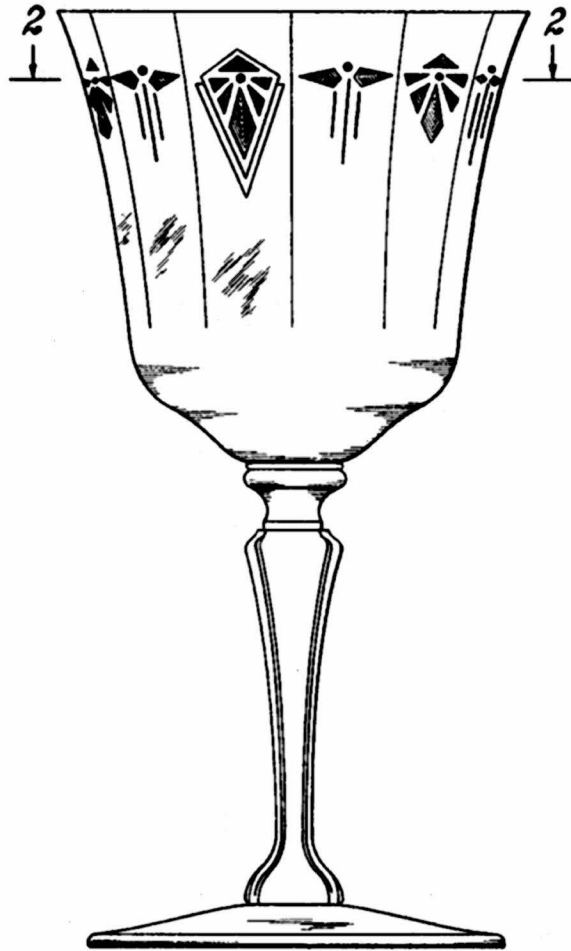
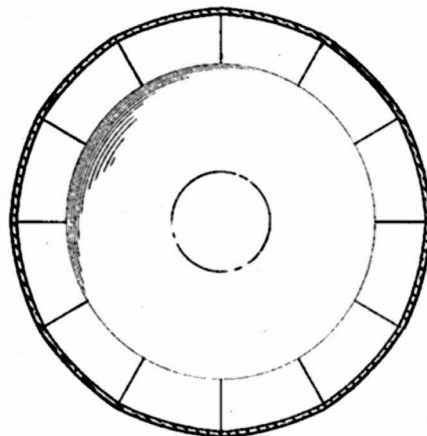

DESIGN FOR A GOBLET OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed December 24, 1931. Serial No. 42,191. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RAY T. KIMBLE, citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, county of Guernsey, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Goblet or Similar Article, fully described and represented in the following specification and the accompanying drawings, forming a part of the same, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of the goblet or similar article showing my new design and

Figure 2 is a cross-section taken on the line 2—2 of Figure 1.

The essential feature of my new design is the ornamental matter on the bowl of the goblet or similar article.
